4. "The rate of population growth will lead to significant economic and social challenges". To what extent do you agree with this statement? [15]
5. "Economic growth is the best way to reduce the poverty gap." Using examples, discuss the extent to which you agree with this statement. [15]
6. "Urban issues present the greatest challenge to society compared with rural issues." To what extent is this statement true? [15]
7. Examine the ways by which energy supply will become a significant global issue in the next 80 years. [15]
8. "The impacts of natural hazards are always local". Discuss this statement. [15]
9. Examine the reasons why the climate in the UK is very different from Germany's, despite being on a similar latitude. [15]
10. For either **Brexit** or **Covid-19**, examine the possible Geographical implications for the near future [15].
