Catilina et ceteri duces coniurationis in domum amici **convenerunt** ut **consilium caperent**. duos homines iusserunt domum Ciceronis **postridie** prima hora ingredi ut eum necarent. Cicero tamen, quod ab uno ex **coniuratis** rem cognovit, villam suam servis armatis defenderat. senatores tandem Catilinam hostem Romae **declaraverunt bellumque gesserunt** ut eum quam celerrime occiderent. in proelio tandem prope urbem **Pistorias**, Catilina necatus est.
