Shrewsbury School is a co-educational boarding school established in 1552. It is an integral part of the historic town of Shrewsbury, surrounded by the beautiful Shropshire countryside.

Rowing was established at the School before 1860 and in 2012 a state-of-the-art boat house was opened. The boat houses, situated on the River Severn are only a short walk from the Main School Building, within the campus.

Excellent training facilities include a range of over 100 boats, a large area for rowing machines and circuit training. An indoor rowing tank allows up to eight students to train together regardless of weather conditions





Coaching

The Lead Coach on all courses is Paul Manser who has coached rowing at Shrewsbury School for over ten years. An old Salopian, he has been involved in the sport since the age of 14 and produced a number of National and International champions. Other coaches have a variety of experience including representing Great Britain.

Residential Course

Students live on campus in one of the School's boarding houses and this forms a base for social activities. Some additional activities on offer will be bubble football, tennis, Canadian canoeing and team games.

All meals and activities are included and we will be aiming for two outings on the river per day. Students will be grouped according to ability and use a variety of boats from singles, doubles, quads and octuples. Students with previous experience will work to develop the skills necessary to progress further in the sport.

All courses open to boys and girls 12-16 years

No experience necessary. 12 year olds are welcome if they feel confident to participate in the full boarding experience and the physical demands of the sport. Experienced rowers will be grouped together and the course will be tailored to their needs.

Day Camp Course

Monday to Friday 9.30am to 4pm. Beginners will start on rowing machines and in the indoor tank, progressing onto the water when confident. Experienced rowers will be grouped together and the course will be tailored to their needs. Students will need to bring a packed lunch and drinks each day.
